Notice is GIVEN of Swindon Borough Council's intention to make the above Order under the provisions of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to revoke the national, 50mph and 30mph speed limit on the various roads in Bishopstone listed below and to introduce the speed limits as follow:

Introduction of 40mph speed limit

New Town Lane with the junction of The Forty for a distance of 400 metres in a north westerly direction

Introduction of 30mph speed limit

Icknield Way from a point 50 metres north east of the junction with New Town Lane for a distance of 400 metres in an easterly direction

Icknield Way from a point 113.4 metres west of the junction of Whatleys Orchard for a distance of 400 metres in a westerly direction

Introduction of 20mph speed limit

Icknield Way from a point 113.4 metres west of the junction of Whatleys Orchard to the junction of Hockerbench in an easterly direction

Icknield Way from a point 50m north east of the junction of New Town Lane to the junction of Hockerbench in a westerly direction

The entire length of The Forty, Whatleys Orchard, West End Lane, Church Lane, Church Walk, New Town Lane, Oxon Place, Cues Lane, Mount Pleasant, Farm Court, The Wyncies, Poveys Place, Hockerbench and High Street.
