

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK Parliamentary election for the Swindon North and Swindon South constituencies

1. An Election is to be held for Members of Parliament to serve the constituencies of Swindon North and Swindon South.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the (Acting) Returning Officer, Room 11, Civic Offices, Euclid Street, Swindon SN1 2JH, during the times stated below.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer at Room 11, Civic Offices, Euclid Street, Swindon SN1 2JH on any day after the date of this notice, on Monday to Friday 10am to 4pm (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4pm on Friday 7 June, 2024.
4. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as banker in the United Kingdom or via BACS to Swindon Borough Council Collections Account, Acc No. 79041360, Sort Code 30-98-41.
5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 4 July, 2024.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 18 June, 2024. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>

New applications to vote by post, and amendments or cancellations of existing postal votes or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Room 11, Civic Offices, Euclid Street, Swindon SN1 2JH by 5pm on Wednesday 19 June, 2024. 8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 26 June, 2024.
