Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places Consolidation) Order 2014 (Variation No 13) Experimental Order 2024

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Following requests from residents and the bus companies within the local area, this Order seeks to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time),

The requests are as a consequence of parking and visibility difficulties encountered on Redhouse Way as a result of parked vehicles

Therefore, to address the concerns raised, Swindon Borough Council proposes to introduce an Experimental Traffic Regulation Order (ETRO) and recommends the introduction of No Waiting at Any Time,

The reason for making this order is as follow;

- a. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising;
- b. For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians),
- c. to assist with the free flow of traffic,
- d. to improve the environment for local residents

This request has been delivered in conjunction with local Ward Councillors. Consultation has been carried out with residents and emergency services and other relevant stakeholders.
