Reminder: The new Synergy Portal is now live

The new Synergy Portal went live from Friday 16th August 2024 and the existing CapitaOne portal was decommissioned at the same time.

Synergy is the new case management system that is taking over from the SEND Portal, or CapitaOne.


You may already be familiar with Synergy as it has already been implemented with a range of education services, such as School Admissions, Educational Psychology, the Education Welfare Service, Early Years and Childcare and Children's Services internal services.


The Local Authority have procured a new case management system due to the end of the existing CapitaOne contract.

Replacing the case management system will change how parent/carers, education settings and professionals submit, view and access information into the SEND Service.

Synergy has an online portal that can be accessed currently by parent/carers, young people, Early Years providers, education settings and some internal professionals from Swindon Borough Council Children's services.

Would you or your employees like to have more knowledge, confidence and skills in the workplace in relation to SEND?

Are you concerned about excluding children when you want to be inclusive to all?

If the answer is yes, then the Dingley's Promise Comic Relief Early Years Inclusion Programme is for you!

The Early Years Inclusion Programme is a programme of training designed to empower early years practitioners to deliver inclusive practices by upskilling them through training and shared information/learning resources. It is expected that the training will increase learners' awareness of the needs of all children, especially those with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND), and their confidence in supporting the learning and well-being of all children in their settings.

The training is free for anyone working with young children such as Health Visitors, Social Workers, Therapeutic Services, Childminders, Early Years Practitioners, Teaching Assistants, Family Support Workers, Early Years Teachers

As a package of training this would normally cost settings up to £600 per practitioner.
