

**Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places
Consolidation) Order 2021 (Variation No 10) Order 2024**

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Following requests from residents within the local area, this Order seeks to introduce no waiting at any time, (double yellow lines)

The requests are as a consequence of obstruction caused by parked vehicles on the Birchwood Road junction with Grange Drive causing difficulties with visibility of approaching vehicles entering and egressing the junction.

Therefore, to address the concerns raised, Swindon Borough Council proposes to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) and recommends the introduction of no waiting at any time, (double yellow lines)

The reason for making this order is as follow;

- a. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising;
- b. For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians),
- c. For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs,
- d. to assist with the free flow of traffic,
- e. to improve the environment for local residents

This request has been delivered in conjunction with local Ward Councillors. Consultation has been carried out with residents and emergency services and other relevant stakeholders.
