

PUBLIC NOTICE

IMPLEMENTATION OF PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS FOR FLEMING WAY SCHEME

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Swindon Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, intend to introduce the following pedestrian crossings:

Signalised Crossings

Cheltenham Street at the junction of Beales Close

Fleming Way between Whalebridge Junction and Milford Street (5 locations)

Toucan Crossings

Fleming Way (south side) at the junction with Fleet Street.

Fleming Way (north side) at the junction with Milford Street.

Milford Street near the junction with Fleming Way.

Puffin Crossing

Fleming Way (south side) at the junction with Whalebridge.

Sparrow Crossing

Fleming Way (north east side) eastbound junction with Whalebridge.

Note- 'Zig Zag' markings will be installed at either side of the crossing which will prohibit stopping on the approach/exit of the crossing.

The scheme at Fleming Way includes the above pedestrian crossing points at key locations along the road to allow for safe pedestrian transit between the north and south of Fleming Way.
