SEN2 2024 Easy Read



The SEN2 Data release is a large data set released every year.

Local Authorities provide the Department for Education with their data, so it can all be stored in one place.

The data is one year behind, and is published in June with the data from the whole of the year before.



The data includes information about individuals with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities, Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCPs), and Appeals.

It is used to make sure that Local Authorities are doing their jobs how, and when, they should be.



As of January 2024, Swindon has a total of 2573 **Open EHCPs**.

That's 249 more than in 2023.



As of January 2024, there are **575,963 Open EHCPs** in the whole of England.

That's 58,914 more than in 2023.






In 2023, Swindon Borough Council received 645 requests for an Education Health and Care Needs Assessment (EHCNA).


This is 59 more requests than in 2022.



In 2023, **138,242** requests for an EHCNA were made in the whole of England.

That's 23760 more than in 2022.





In 2023, Swindon Borough Council issued **371 New EHCPs**.

This is 51 more EHCPs issued than in 2022.



In 2023, **84,428 EHCPs** were issued in the whole of England.

That's 18,072 more EHCPs issued than in 2022.



73.68% of all new EHCPs issued in 2023 were issued within 20-weeks in Swindon.

This does not include EHCPs issued due to an appeal decision.

This is 2.57% more than in 2022.






49.15% of all new EHCPs issued in 2023 in the whole of England were issued within 20-weeks. This does not include EHCPs issued due to an appeal decision.

This is 1.48% more than in 2022.


This means that Swindon is well above the national average!



In Swindon, the largest percentage of EHCPs are for children and young people aged 11-15 years old.

That's 987 children and young people!

Only a small number of young people aged 20-25 have an EHCP in Swindon.



In Swindon, the largest percentage of EHCPs are for males.

That's **1835** children and young people!





In Swindon, the largest percentage of EHCPs are for children and young people listed as 'White'.

That's **1792** children and young people!

Only **8.24% of EHCPs** in Swindon are for Asian / Asian British children and young people.

Only **2.64% of EHCPs** in Swindon are for Black / African / Caribbean / Black British children and young people.



In Swindon, most children and young people with an EHCP are in a mainstream school – **46.48%**.

That's **1196** children and young people!

Nationally, **43.30**% of children and young people with an EHCP are in a mainstream school.



In Swindon, **34.01%** of children and young people with an EHCP are in a Special School.

That's 875 children and young people!

Nationally, **32.27%** of children and young people with an EHCP are in a Special School.

In Swindon, during 2023 there were a total of 100 **mediations** – that's 21 more than in 2022.

There were also **14** Tribunals during this time – 2 more than in 2022.
